RULES & REGULATIONS

(A) Qualification

1. Only members (include Fellow, Corporate & Associate) of The Air Conditioning & Refrigeration Association of Hong Kong are eligible to join this competition.
2. Players of each team must be a full-time employee of the Company.
3. Each number is allowed to register not more than two teams. Each team is allowed to register a maximum of 6 players throughout the tournament. Once registered, no replacement of the player is allowed throughout the tournament.
4. The Captain of each team is responsible for ensuring that each player of his team is qualified to play. The Committee may order to disqualify the team for ignorance of the rules or failure to check adequately.

(B) Format of the Competition

1. Each member may register up to 2 teams, each consisting of maximum 6 bowlers (either female or male) including 3 reserves.
2. The competition will be held in 2 days. There will be 3 rounds per day, with 3 bowlers from each team each playing one game per round making up a total of 9 games per team in each day. The team with the highest total pinfalls after 2 days will be the Champion. The team with the 2nd highest and 3rd highest will be the 1st Runners-up and 2nd Runners-up respectively.
3. Each female bowler will be granted a handicap of 20 pins per game.
4. 110 pins (w/o handicap) will be granted for an absent bowler for each game regardless of female or male bowler.

5. At least 2 bowlers from each team must be present at each round. If the 3rd bowler present within the first 3 frames of the games, he is allowed to join the team and bowl the following frames only. If the 3rd bowler present after the first 3 frames, he will not allowed to join the team and will be treated as blind scores (110 pins).
6. A team will be considered conceding a walkover if, at 10 minutes after the schedule time, less than 2 players are present.
7. The foul line system will not be used.
8. Change of bowlers are allowed only after the completion of each round.

(C) Verification of Scores

The scores of each game should be verified by the corresponding team captain and the team captain of the opposite lane by signing on the official score sheet.

(D) Warm Up and Practice

There should be no warm-up or practice session before a match starts.

(E) Check In

Teams captains must check in 15 minutes before the commencement of the first round on each day.

(F) Prizes and Special Awards

Team Awards : The Champion, 1st & 2nd Runners-up.

Special Awards : Highest single game and highest 3 game series
(In case of female, handicap will also be counted)

(Note : For “Special Awards”, each individual is entitled to one award. In the event that the individual scores two successes in “Special Awards”, only the highest 3 game series is awarded and the highest single game will be awarded to the second highest.)

(G) Final Decision

Any matters, objection, complaint and dispute which arises out of this competition and is not covered in this rules and regulations will be decided by the tournament committee whose decision in all cases shall be final.
